How it's Made:

A Pencil Brush also known as an "Applicator Brush" is typically made with a round metal tube handle or a plastic rod handle. A metal handle is typically made with the end crimped to hold the bristles into the handle or they can be glued. The plastic handle has a hole drilled on the end where the bristles are glued.
